weeks

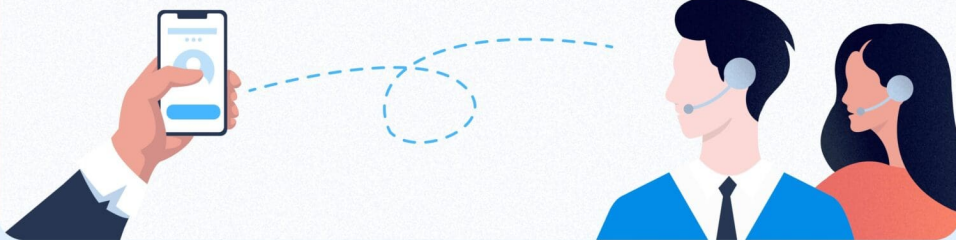
6 to 8 weeks before your deadline if:
